SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The NJSOA is once again taking applications for its annual scholarship program. Six (6) one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollar scholarships will be awarded. To be eligible, the following rules must apply:

- (1) You must be a 100% dues paying member in good standing.
- (2) You may only receive one (1) scholarship. Past winners are not eligible.
- (3) Applications are considered for Members, Spouse, Children, Grandchildren or Legal Guardianship.
- (4) Recipient must be enrolled and accepted at an accredited school of higher education.
- (5) Scholarships will be paid directly to the school and applied towards the student's account.

All approved applications will receive a ticket for a random drawing. One half of the ticket will be affixed to the application.
